ORGANIC EQUIVALENCY AFFIRMATION
For Export of Organic Crops and Products to Canada

Under an equivalency arrangement organic crops and processed products that are certified to the USDA National Organic Standards, are not required to obtain additional Canadian certification. Under this arrangement, a formal export document *is not* required to accompany each shipment from the US to Canada. However, written documentation with the below attestation statement is necessary to verify that additional requirements have been met. **These attestations can be made by either the operation or the certifying agent.**
